- Reinforce academic concepts introduced during one-on-one enrichment sessions (e.g., pre-literacy, numeracy, fine/gross motor) through hands-on exploration and play.
- Observe and document student growth using portfolio tools and anecdotal records.
- Model respectful language, mindfulness techniques, and positive redirection.
- Collaborate closely with other Guides and the Academic Enrichment Director for curriculum planning and student support.
- Foster meaningful relationships with families and contribute to the overall village culture of Community Co.
